To Whom It May Concern:

As you most likely are aware, California's Proposition 65 warning requirements will change on August 30, 2018. The State's list of carcinogens and reproductive toxins contains nearly 900 chemicals, some with specific risk assessments stated as No Significant Dose Level (NSDL, for carcinogens) or Maximum Allowable Dose Levels (MADL, for reproductive toxicants).

To the best of our knowledge and abilities, all products provided by HS Manufacturing, LLC; HS Foam Fabricators, LLC and HSM Diversified Products & Services, LLC (collectively, "HSM") do not contain any of the listed Prop 65 chemicals nor do they have content that exceeds NSDL and MADL limits.

We see no reason to utilize Prop 65 warning labels on your products due to your use of HSM products/components. Therefore the new labeling requirement - in which specific Prop 65 chemicals must be listed on a product's label - does <u>not</u> apply due to your use of any HSM product.

We at HSM are not Prop 65 experts. This letter is not legal opinion. We recommend that you seek legal counsel specific to your own situation regarding Prop 65 requirements.
